SPRING TESTING

It's almost time for Spring testing. Spring testing will take place May 15-18, 2023. These are in-person tests for all students in grade 6-8 and all students taking EOC courses (Algebra 1, English 2, US History, and Biology). 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INTENT TO RETURN

Please make sure to complete your student's Intent to Return and Registration Forms to secure your student's spot for the 23-24 School Year.

Registration will open to the public on April 1st and seats are limited.

These are two separate forms, and you will need to complete both.

Please log into the PowerSchool Parent Portal for your student. If you do not have an account you will need to create one.

1. Go to cie.powerschool.com/public
2. Either log in or create an account
3. Link to your student by entering their First and Last name
4. Access ID will be first letter and full last name (ex. nstroud)
5. Password will be their 8 digit birthdate (ex. 08032022)
6. Once in the portal you will go the bottom left and see Intent to Return and Registration

SCHOOL CLIMATE

Please be sure to fill out the School Climate Survey! You can find it by logging into PowerSchool and clicking Forms on the left hand side. Choose 2023 Climate Survey. This is for all parents and students!

VIRTUAL SC

Students who are taking an initial credit course with VirtualSC must sign up for virtual proctoring via MonitorEDU. Registration will be open through the last day of the final exam window, May 12, 2023. **The only date options for virtual proctoring are available: May 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12.** Because MonitorEDU is a third-party company, a \$15 fee, per exam, is required. The fee is paid by the student/parent/guardian directly on the [MonitorEDU webpage](#).

Students must meet the technology requirements as posted on MonitorEDU's website to use this service. Students must be able to verify their identification using a photo ID.



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SUMMER COURSES

If students are wishing to take summer courses, this must be approved, and courses will be through VirtualSC. Please note exams will be given using the MonitorED Proctor. Please reach out for more information.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

Any student who is wishing to take Dual Enrollment courses must have permission from Dr. Griffis and a MOA must be completed between SC Preparatory Academy and the college.

IF THERE IS NOT AN MOA AGREEMENT, THIS COLLEGE CREDIT WILL NOT BE GRANTED FOR HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT.

The course must be approved by SC Prep as well as the college for Dual Enrollment.
